FRIDAY, APRIL 24 EARLY ARRIVAL JACKPOT

ENTRY FEES: \$20 per adult, juniors, and level 4 card holders All level 3 and under youth entries are FREE!

Competition to start at 9am "No X" format with 5 rounds guaranteed

Men and Women will shoot in their own divisions as well as the Level 4 youth of their gender. (Annie Oakley and Billy the Kid shoot in their own separate contest for their own awards.) The format will be "No X Out Option", see page 24 of the CFDA Gunslinger's Rules, Guidelines and Handbook-10th edition for more information. This format allows for more rounds for each shooter than a standard X contest, with a guarantee of at least five rounds per shooter. All shooters will qualify for the shoot-off. The shoot-off will be set from the bottom up with a 1X elimination. Cash prizes will be awarded during the Saturday night banquet.

BRING YOUR OWN shot gun primer loads. NO SHATTERING WAX ALLOWED AT THIS FACILITY!
(Please contact Etta Mae if you plan to fly and will need assistance with ammo. \$10 per 50 rounds with brass returned)

ENTRY FEES: \$100 Men & Ladies \$60 Junior Boys, Junior Girls, or Level 4 Youth Card Holders \$25 All other Youth Divisions

State Championship Main Match to start at 9am. Regular 4X Match with 7, possibly 8 rounds if time allows, shot on Saturday. As contestants X-out of the main match, please select one item from our "Thanks for Playing" table.

SATURDAY NIGHT AWARDS BANQUET (\$20 per person)

6:30pm the awards ceremony followed by the banquet will begin in the Carey Foster Hall, just North of the shooting range on the fairgrounds. The banquet will be prepared and served by our local FFA students and/or Alumni. Proceeds from this event go to help our local FFA chapters!

SUNDAY, APRIL 26 MAIN MATCH CONTINUES TO THE TOP 5 AFTER BRACKET MATCHES

BRACKET MATCHES BEGIN

Everyone is welcome to participate! This event is included in the Main Match entry fee!

Competition to start at 8am Range A & B. 2x, Nevada 8 Format. The top 3 awarded in each of the 4 brackets.

TWO VERY IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS THAT WE ALL MUST ADHERE TO:

1. Per our contract with the Fairgrounds, “**NO GLASS BEVERAGE containers are allowed on Fairground property (plastic or can only.)**” Your tent area and RV area are considered your personal and private space. Anywhere else is considered Fairground property.
2. Per our agreement with the Prineville Police Department, Prineville Ordinances, and the Crook County Fairgrounds, there will be **NO ALCOHOL at the banquet in the Carey Foster Hall or at the Pavilion Tent where the shooting ranges are located.**
3. *Due to the facility style, if there is a shot over the top of the backstop, it will be an automatic MATCH disqualification.*
