

9th Edition Addendum #1. Page 9 (Shooter's With Disabilites)

General Exemption #1 - Wheel Chair Competitors

1. **Holster Position** - Positioning a holster on a wheel chair, must be handled on a case by case basis, under the guidance of local officials as prescribed above. Care should be taken so that holster placement does not create a positioning and/or leverage advantage not available to fellow competitors. A leather or equivalent leg shield must be worn by a wheel chair competitor.
2. **Remaining Behind the Firing Line** - The gun and holster must remain behind the firing line for wheel chair competitors, instead of the feet. Any part of the wheel chair shooter's feet and legs that are extended over the firing line must be protected with additional leather or similar guards.
3. **Technical Rule 17** - There will be no exemptions for Technical Rule #17.
