

RANGE OFFICER RECERTIFICATION REQUEST

Recertification is required every two years. There is no charge for recertification unless an RO pin needs to be replaced.

Recertification is conducted by a Regulator or certified RO Instructor who attends the match. It can be done at any CFDA sanctioned match from the cub level to a titled match. Town Folk Alleys are excluded.

Recertification is a two step process. The RO can attend either a recertification class or an RO class. The RO will then spend some time being observed running the range and carrying out an RO's duties. These steps can be done at different matches conducted and observed by a different Regulator or certified RO Class Instructor.

The Regulator or certified RO Instructor will then sign off on each step for each RO. The ROs that have completed both steps will keep their pin and receive a certified RO card with an expiration date on it. It will be each RO's responsibility to check their expiration date and recertify when necessary.
