



WELCOME to the 2016 Colorado State CFDA National Championships! Tuesday July 26th thru Sunday July 31st in Town Park

Pagosa Springs is located at 7200 feet in the San Juan range of the Rocky Mountains. We are about 60 miles east of Durango on US Highway 160 and about 50 miles north of Chama New Mexico on US Highway 84. Because we are above 7000 feet in is extremely important for you stay hydrated and rested while you are here. It may take a day or so for you to acclimate to our altitude if you are not used to it.

Pagosa Springs is home to the largest natural mineral hot springs in the world. The San Juan River runs through town. Our events will be in Town Park adjacent to the San Juan River in the heart of downtown Pagosa Springs. Town Park is located at the intersection of US 160 and Hot Springs Blvd. The park is on the SE corner of the intersection. Find Goodman's Department Store at 402 Pagosa Street (US 160) and you will find the park.

Shooter's popups, tables and chairs will be allowed in the shooter's area. Space may be limited so it will be first come first served. We will have a shooter's tent with tables and chairs for those who cannot bring their own. We will provide water for shooters and their guests in the shooter's area at no charge. A monetary donation will be welcome.

We will not take a lunch break during the matches. Food and beverages will be welcome in the shooter's area. Absolutely NO live ammo or firearms unrelated to the contests will be allowed in the shooter's area.

No alcohol or illegal or illicit drugs including marijuana will be allowed in the shooter's area. Anyone who appears under the influence or otherwise impaired will not be allowed in the shooter's area or be allowed to compete.

The end of July and beginning of August is our "monsoon" season. Expect a shower of two on any given day. They usually don't last long and are normally not heavy. Please bring your rain gear just in case.

2016 Colorado State and CFDA National Championships General Information

All CFDA rules will apply to all matches. You must be a CFDA member in good standing to compete in any of these matches. Please be prepared to show either your CFDA membership card or your lifetime badge at registration.

We will supply all of the ammo for all of the matches. CFDA cartridges will be loaded to CFDA specifications by Mongo. If 209 primers and wax are used in some matches they will be laded by club members and made available to shooters.

All Billy the Kid and Annie Oakley Youth competitors (referred to as BK and AO) except level 4 shooting with the adults will shoot for free. Level 2 two handed and Level 3 and one handed shooters will shoot together. BK and AO may shoot together depending on the turnout. There will be awards for both the top BK and AO shooters.

Junior shooters and Level 4 Youth shooters shooting with the adults will pay a reduced entry fee but they will shoot in the adult divisions. They will be eligible for the same awards as the adults. There will also be separate awards for the top Junior Men's and Junior Ladies shooters.

State Championship Match Tuesday July 26th & Wednesday July 27th

The match will be a 4X - 3 out of 5 (3 winning hits wins your bout) match. There will be a top 5 Fabulous Five Men's and Ladies 2X shoot off for the title. We will try to complete seven rounds of the main match on the first day unless other circumstances interfere with the match. There will not be a Category match scheduled for the State Championship match due to time constraints. Awards will be given out right after the match ends.

Thursday July 28th

Thursday will be an "open day for those that wish to explore Pagosa Springs and the surrounding area or just be lazy. For those that want to shoot there will be a Practice match at 9am in the morning for open to all. Entry fee will be \$15.00. All registered shooters in the match will shoot together regardless of their Division or Category. Prizes and or awards will be given to the top three finishers. Shotgun primer ammo may be used but it will be provided by the club. There will also be a Town Folk Ally going on. Shooters will be able to practice with their own ammo when there are no civilians shooting on the range. If you do not have your own ammo then ammo will be available to purchase at our cost.

National Championship Category Match Friday July 29th

It is not mandatory to shoot in the category match. First place National Champions will be given awards to recognize their title. The match format is to be determined by the number of registered shooters. The match will take most of the day.

National Championship Match Saturday July 30th and Sunday July 31st

The match will be a 4X - 3 out of 5 (3 winning hits wins your bout) match. There will be a top 7 Magnificent Seven Men's and Ladies 2X shoot off for the title. We will try complete seven rounds of the main match on the first day unless other circumstances interfere with the match. Awards will be given out right after the match ends.

Second Chance Matches – Wednesday July 27th and Sunday July 31st

There will be a "second chance" match held during both the State and the National matches for those shooters who go out of the main match early. The Match Director will decide the cut off round to be eligible for these matches depending on the number of shooters remaining in the main match. The cut off may be after the last round on the first day or after the first round on the second day. If you go out of the main match before the cut off you will be able to shoot in the second chance match regardless of your main match placement. If the top Five or Seven have been determined in any Division of the championship match before the cut off has been reached for the match then they too will be eligible to compete in the second chance match. The State second chance match will begin on Wednesday Morning. The National second chance match will begin on Sunday morning. The entry fee will be \$15.00 for each. The second chance match format is to be determined.
