

## 2021 LA State Championship

### Event Information

This year, the 2021 Louisiana State Championship of Cowboy Fast Draw will be held at the Louisiana State Fairgrounds, in the Ag Building, 3208 Pershing Blvd, Shreveport, LA 71109. This will be our first year in Shreveport, LA and we are looking forward to putting on a first-class event in a first-class venue. The Ag Building is a huge, climate-controlled building with plenty of space.

Tables and chairs will be provided. Concessions will be available. Vendors are welcome.

The Banquet this year will be a Cajun Feast, at the range venue. The cost is \$15.00. The menu is Gumbo, jambalaya, and red beans with rice.

**RV hookups** are available for those who want to use them. With over 500 RV spots, they can certainly accommodate us. Nightly rental is \$25.00 and includes water, sewer, and electrical (30 or 50 amp). Call the Fairgrounds at 318-635-1361 and ask for Lisa.

**Hotels:** We have two host hotels this year.

Of course, Shreveport has lots of hotels, and you might decide to make other arrangements. These host hotels are approximately 4 miles from the State Fairgrounds, just down the interstate. You may find less expensive accommodations, but our sources advise us that the hotels near the airport sometimes support a clientele that does not play well with Cowboy Fast Draw.

Chief Run-A-Muck has coordinated a crawfish boil for Friday afternoon at the Fairgrounds. It's free, and a limited amount (200 lbs), but we'll eat them till they are gone.

Shreveport/ Bossier is hosting Holiday In Dixie that weekend, a festival on the river bank to the Red River. There will be music and food vendors on the river bank all weekend. The Shreveport/Bossier area also boasts several casinos on both sides of the river, and these are two miles (approximately) from the Fairgrounds.

Shreveport/Bossier seems to be a wonderful venue for the Louisiana State Championship, and everyone we have talked with is excited to see us come to Shreveport. We are looking forward to hosting this event this year, and we hope to see you all on the line.
