

Range Master Re-Qualification Process (Updated: January 2020)

Qualification Process for New Range Masters

Most of our members are aware that to Qualify as a New CFDA Range Master. The course must be taught by a CFDA Regulator or Approved Instructor, that is still the process for New Range Masters.

Re-Qualification Process

Last year we reviewed our policies regarding the 2-Year Re-Qualification Program. We were shocked when we found that about 2/3rds of our members who made the commitment to go through our Range Master Training Program were expired. We determined that the main reason for the high expiration rate was due to time, distance, and lack of available opportunities to find a Range Master Class to attend. We decided that a change in this process was necessary.

First, if you go to our CFDA Website and under the Rules and Range Officer Training Section, bring up the **List of Qualified Range Master List, and check your current status and renewal date.**

There, you will find that this list had been updated in 2019 to add TWO YEARS, so at this time there are no expired Range Masters. But, for Range Master wishing to Re-Qualify there is a new process that you must pay attention to starting in 2020.

Our New Qualified Range Master Re-Qualification Process has been streamlined with a simple Log Sheet to document your continuing education by keeping in practice and honing your skills at CFDA events through the year. The goal is to maintain your proficiency, and it is very easy to document for submittal of your Range Master Renewal.

On the Log Sheet:

You will find that there are 7 Boxes on this form that must be completed, and you have the next two years to do so.

At Least One Page Must Be Submitted Containing Seven Entries Using Any Combination of the Following:

- 1 Range Mastering at a Class "B" or Higher Event (Running at least 4 Groups)**
- 2 Serving as an Announcer at a Class "B" or Higher Event. (Running at least 4 Groups)**
- 3 Instructing a Range Officer Class at a Local Club.**
- 4 Attending a Range Master's Course as a Refresher.**
- 5 Serving as Match Director or Chief Range Master at a Class B or Higher Event.**
- 6 Serving as a Match Director at a Class "C" Event.**
- 7 Organizing and Serving as Chief Range Master at a Try Cowboy Fast Draw Event (According to CFDA Guidelines)**

Qualified Range Masters can complete and turn this form into CFDA at any time before their renewal date to extend their expiration date two years beyond the time this form is submitted and approved. i.e., completed form submitted and approved on 11-15-20, will change your expiration date to 11-15-22, and so on.

We hope you find this program much more enjoyable to complete. Please keep practicing your skills, having fun, and becoming a recognized asset to our sport.
